<b>E.</b>	<b>Review of Board Policies and Administrative Procedures (BPs/APs)</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- CCLC BP/AP Update #46, 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Note to update the footnote to reflect the first read on September 10, 2025</li><li>○ BP3433: Question - 3<sup>rd</sup> paragraph, why was the word "all" allegations and Title IX removed? Strikeouts make the policy consistent 2024 federal regulation being overturned. This item will move forward to the Board for a first read.</li><li>○ AP3420: should this mention the number of faculty included on</li></ul></li></ul>	Ostash

	<p>this committee; and is this group subject to the Brown Act. This change only reflects the driver's license requirement which is legally required. This item will move forward for implementation as presented. Oshtash will bring this back for a first read at the next meeting to address the number of faculty and brown act requirements.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ AP3430: Question - where will we address sex discrimination? This item will move forward for implementation as presented. Ostash will reach out for legal guidance related to sex discrimination language.</li> <li>○ AP3434: This item will move forward for implementation noting that contact information will be updated once the VCHR hire is identified, and each college contact will be identified as well.</li> <li>○ AP3436: This item will move forward for implementation. Campus specific processes will be brought back to the Council for information.</li> <li>○ AP3501: This item will move forward for implementation as presented. Campus specific process will be brought back to Council for information.</li> <li>○ AP3516: This item will not go forward at this time. Ostash will revise language in paragraph two for clarity and will bring back to DCC for a first read.</li> <li>○ AP3550: This item will not go forward at this time. This item along with AP6950 be reviewed together and come back for a first read together.</li> <li>○ AP6450 and BP7260 are listed. KCCD is not adopting either procedure or policy.</li> <li>○ AP7600: two colleges will have public safety officers, and one will have police so there are two versions. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ This item will not go forward at this time. The highlighted areas will be specified, and this item will come back to DCC for a first read.</li> </ul> </li> <li>○ BP7230: Question about why part-time students are called out in the language. The legally required change specifically refer to student tutors. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ This item will not go forward at this time. HR will verify the policy related to all students.</li> </ul> </li> <li>○ BP3015: BC catalog information regarding military credit will be removed. This item will go forward for implementation with this change. Ostash will discuss with Vice Presidents regarding local decision to go beyond the legally required language.</li> <li>○ BP7210: This item will not go forward for implementation. Ostash will bring this item back to DCC for a first read.</li> <li>○ BP/AP6910: This item will go forward for implementation with the CCLC recommendation language only.</li> </ul> <p>- CCLC BP/AP Update #47, 1<sup>st</sup> Reading</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ BP7130 will be added to update #47, and will be sent as a first reading via email.</li> </ul>
