

Kern Community College District Administrative Procedure Chapter 4 – Academic Affairs

AP 4104 Contract Education

Reference: Title 5 Section 55170

Note: This procedure is legally advised.

The District may contract <u>for</u> instructional programs and classes <u>to be offered at</u> <u>the request of</u>. with public or private agencies or groups. to offer

Contract Education programs may only be offered pursuant to a written agreement between the District and the entity desiring the program, setting forth the program details and the price per student.

The Board of Trustees must ratify all such agreements.

The Chief Instructional Officer or the Vice Chancellor, Education Services will be responsible for determining if a course or program may be offered through contract education.

<u>The District may only claim state apportionment for a course if the course is open</u> to the general student population. If the course or program is not open to the general student population, then the District cannot claim FTES and the program must pay for itself.
