## AP 4236 Advanced Placement Credit

## Rely Primarily Upon the Advice and Judgment

Education Code Section 79500: <u>Title 5 Section 55052</u>

Note: This procedure is legally required

Any student who passes a College Board Advanced Placement (AP) examination with a minimum score of three (3) in a subject matter will be awarded credit in a General Education area with a subject matter similar to that of the AP examination.

For any AP examination that a college does not offer a course similar in content, the respective college <u>District</u> will award credit in the General Education area shown on the California Community College General Education AP List. If <u>there is no</u>a General Education area <u>does not that</u> fits the AP Examination, the <u>District</u>respective college may award elective credit.

<u>A student's academic record will be annotated to reflect credit earned through an AP examination.</u>

The District Each college shall post its Advanced Placement Credit procedure on its website.
