

**College Council Report to FCDC

I. Accreditation ISER: Standard IC

This standard is about Institutional Integrity. We show institutional integrity in a number of ways:

1. We make sure information we give is clear, accurate, and truthful.
2. We provide a public catalog that meets ACCJC requirements.
3. We tell the public about our academic quality through public assessments.
4. Our programs state their purpose, content, etc.
5. We review policies and make sure they match actual practice.
6. Give students complete picture of their costs of education.
7. We have broad policies on academic freedom.
8. We have clear policies on academic honesty.
9. We encourage objective investigations of different points of view.
10. We publish codes of conduct for employees and students.
11. Colleges in foreign countries still follow ACCJC standards and policies.
12. We agree to do what ACCJC requires so it can accredit us.
13. We demonstrate honest relationships with our external agencies.
14. We make sure quality education is our top priority.

II. State of the College

Among other items of success, the report points to a 7% increase in FTES from the previous year and completion rate success in various programs. Here's a sample:

1. In 2012, Metamajors awarded 31 degrees for transfer. In 2016, 491 degrees were awarded.
2. 14% more students are completing college-level English during their first year and 7% more students are completing college-level math during their first year compared to 2011-2012.
3. Dual enrollment has grown to 2,936 students last spring from 168 students in fall 2013.
