*Veterans Club:* The Vet Fest is on Oct 9.

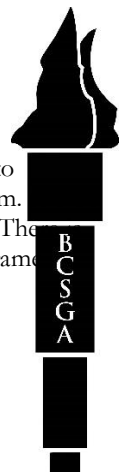
*M.E.Ch.A Club:* There will be a Health Panel Oct 9 at 4 p.m. in the Fireside Room.
