## **Best Practice(s):**

The Counseling Department's Educational Planning class, Student Development B1, is a focused and practical first semester course that provides an excellent opportunity for students to gain an understanding of available programs and resources at BC, and, most importantly, to do the short and long term educational and career planning that is so critical to student success. Learning outcomes for STDV B1 include:

- Locate, navigate, and utilize educational and career resources
- Identify BC programs, policies, procedures and services
- Identify and evaluate educational and career goals and plan how to reach them
- Manage time and responsibilities and be able to assess and measure progress towards completion of education/career goals

While we have lost counselors to retirements and reassignments over the years and reduced sections of this course, we have one of the highest retention and success rates in both the college and in the state compared to similar educational planning courses. We accomplish this by the following:

- Even though the course only meets for 9 hours, we connect with our students in a meaningful ways by learning their names, majors and showing them we care about their dreams and goals.
- We assist them in translating those dreams into actionable educational pathways (comprehensive sep).
- The connections that we create in that course, last the entire time the student is at BC, because they come back and visit us for support.
- We encourage students to engage in the process of their own future.
- We teach them to become independent, yet are there as a resource.
