## **Additional Information and Comments:**

- 1) Inspection/Certification of auto lifts and cranes, and periodic maintenance and inspection of large equipment needs to continue. Our recent safety inspection also identified safety needs that are now being purchased through the department budget.
- 2) In the past, VTEA funding has covered staff development activities. This year, many of those requests are not able to be funded. Only a couple of programs in the department receive grant funding other than VTEA.
- 3) Due to past budget issues, we have not been able to maintain a program of replacement of old, non-repairable, and identified unsafe equipment as we need to do. This will be accomplished on a multiple year period.
