**Notes**<sup>1</sup> Source: ODS Reports (July, 2013)<sup>2</sup> Student Headcount, *Unduplicated*: Number of students enrolled on census day, where each student is counted one time.<sup>3</sup> F-t-F: Face to Face instructional delivery mode.<sup>4</sup> Enrollment: Every course in which students are enrolled on census day.<sup>5</sup> Students/Section: Student enrollments per section on census day. Cross-listed sections are not combined.<sup>6</sup> Acronyms FTES and FTEF represent full-time equivalent students and full-time equivalent faculty, respectively.<sup>7</sup> FTES/FTEF: A measurement of productivity where the generally accepted target is 17.5.<sup>8</sup> Success rate numerator: Number of course enrollments with a successful passing grade (A,B,C,P/CR).

Retention rate numerator: Number of course enrollments retained through the semester (grade = A,B,C,P/CR,D,F,NP/NC,I).
