Cross-listed sections are not combined.⁶ Acronyms FTES and FTEF represent full-time equivalent students and full-time equivalent faculty, respectively.⁷ FTES/FTEF: A measurement of productivity where the generally accepted target is 17.5.⁸ Success rate numerator: Number of course enrollments with a successful passing grade (A,B,C,P/CR).
