Hi Ben,

I ran the grades for Fall 2017 and in general all courses looked like they did pretty well with over 85% of students passing each section. I did want to let you know about a few sections where students had lower than 85% pass rates (earned at least a D). Those considered to not have passed received Incompletes, an F or withdrew from the course after the deadline. These may be anomalies and some of the courses had low enrollment but I thought I would share in case you want to reach out to the instructors to see if there were issues.

Although it was a small class, the one that is most concerning is Art B1 offered at Vista. Only half the students passed the course and it had a high number of students who withdrew. This course also had a higher percentage of African American students. The poor outcome for this course skewed the overall passage rate for African American students as a whole.

- North High
 - STDV B3 - 9 students (82%) – Justin Smith, taught 2 sections, the other section had 96% pass rate
- Regional Occupational Center:
 - CRIM B1 – 10 students (83%), taught by Anthony Mosley, taught two sections, 95% in other section
 - CRPS B4 – 2 students (67%), Carolee Trimble, taught two sections, 100% in other section
- Shafter High:
 - STDV B3 – 4 students (80%) taught by Kourtney Ciaravino, taught one section and another section with 5 students (83%) taught by Sharaya Durant, taught one section
- South High
 - STDV B3 – 10 students (83%), taught by Joseph Gonzales, taught four sections, 100%, 100%, 90%
- Vista Continuation:
 - **Art B1 – 5 students (50%) taught by Jamee Eaton, only taught one section**
- West High:
 - STDV B3 – 8 students (80%), taught by Michael Youngblood, taught 5 sections, 100%, 94%, 86%, 100%
