<p>Request: New computers for the two faculty members in Delano.</p> <p>Justification: The ISIT tech plan for 2017-2020 states that "a three- to five-year replacement cycle has been unofficially agreed upon, and that office computers have historically gone longer than three years before replacement." Faculty who use the office computers in DST 1007, provide the following narrative regarding computer/monitor replacement: "The computer has been here for the four years I've been here, and it was the same computer that was here when I arrived, which means it is due for replacement. I have had issues with the fan not starting, the mouse is glitchy, and the screen (17inch) is too small for effective work between documents and different programs (e.g. toggling between tabs for multiple websites/programs like Canvas and Turnitin and InsideBC and Microsoft Word,etc. is a time drain). Consumer Reports explains that a screen with "greater width allows for much easier side-by-side page viewing as well as more viewable spreadsheet columns at once, requiring less scrolling." I would like a larger screen both for my eyesight and the more efficient use of time. If my current computer tower meets the specs of the new screen and has the capabilities necessary for new programs like Starfish, then I'm fine requesting just a screen upgrade for now."</p>
