According to the data provided by EMSI, the net gain in our area for drafters and related careers will be 25 per year and the average median hourly earnings for these areas is \$27.86.
4. Our faculty is in constant contact with industry through advisory committee meetings, site visits, and phone contact. We vet all of our curriculum through the advisory committee on an annual basis and seek input on new or emerging technologies as well as employment needs of industry. Our faculty serve as point-of-contact for employers seeking employees on a regular basis.
5. Our annual completion target for the JSC is 45. The CA is new, but we have set a goal of 25 certificates. In the past three years we have awarded 114 Job Skills Certificates. Based on these results, we hope to expand our course offerings to the new Southwest Campus on Stockdale Highway and offer classes to a greater portion of the community.
6. The greatest factor impacting this certificate is the lack of space for our programs to expand. We share space and resources with architecture, engineering, and the industrial automation degree, all which have been growing as well. Additionally, students who pursue these other degrees often see the value of our certificates and work toward the CA and JSC as well. We will continue to communicate with students and community about the availability and value of these certificates.
