The Public Health Science Program currently has one full time faculty who has completed the curriculum development of the AST for Public Health Science and Certificate of Achievement for the Health Navigator. The PBHS courses are GE approved, CSU transferable and anticipated to be both CSU GE and UC approved in the near future. The number of majors has grown from 0 to over 49 in a course of one year. In addition, CSUB is currently in the process of developing a Public Health Degree and has an interest in supporting the pathway development locally.

The program works well within the Early College program and there is a real opportunity to provide classes across all the rural locations. This program would also fit a need and has an interest in expanding to the Incarcerated Program. The request for an additional faculty will support the continue growth of this program and will support the following Strategic Goals:

- Expand the number of certificate programs in rural communities by providing classes required for the Health Navigator Certificate of Achievement.
- Establish and expand student support services in satellite sites. (i.e. BC Southwest, Weill, etc.)
- Support the expansion of dual enrollment by creating a support system for high school teachers who met minimum qualifications though distance learning/hybrid opportunities.
- Increase student exposure to top transfer institutions by pathway by promoting public health science pathway as a degree option

Not outlined in the Strategic Goals, ensure capacity building. Currently, one person is leading this program and there is a need to cross train and grow the program. Hiring another person, ensures long term sustainability of the programmatic side of public health science.
