A BILL

Proposal of BCSGA Constitutional Amendment

1 *Whereas, one the Bakersfield College's goal is "Student Success: Become an exemplary model of student success*
2 *by developing and implementing best practices";*

3 *Whereas, BCSGA is developing a more efficient and effective government to represent the student population at*
4 *Bakersfield College;*

5 *Whereas, BCSGA needs to be able to manage the Association in an effective manner that incorporates best*
6 *practices of running a student government association at a community college;*

7 *Whereas, in order for the government to be more direct and strategically plan for future growth;*

8 *Whereas, the Association should be more accountable for its owns actions, while implementing self-governed*
9 *checks-and-balances within the three branches of the Association;*

1 *Whereas, the proposed constitutional changes clearly marks the responsibilities, powers, and duties of each branch*
2 *of the Association and its officers;*

3 *Be it enacted by the Senate of the Bakersfield College Student Government Association that the proposed*
4 *amendments to the BCSGA Constitution grant full power and authority to carry out its function and mission;*

5 *Be it further enacted upon the written approval of the President of Bakersfield College, the proposed constitutional*
6 *amendments be submitted to the Bakersfield College Student Body for approval by majority vote at the 2015 General*
7 *Elections;*

8 *Be it further enacted that upon confirmation of passing, the revised BCSGA Constitution shall take effect*
9 *immediately following the certification of the BCSGA Officers of the 91st Session.*
