
### 8. NEW BUSINESS

i. Status of approval of DJ

<u>Discussion:</u> Two quotes were provided to the committee, where one of the quotes was presented as being the preferred candidate. The reasoning behind the preferred candidate was that the DJ had remained in contact with the department in arranging a schedule for the event is selected, came in to meet with the Director about it, and also had a better priced quote than the other DJ. However, it was expressed by the committee that they would want to hear a demo instead of picking the 'economical' choice right away. It was also suggested by a public member that they had a personal connection to a DJ that could be used for the event.

ii. Bungee run/Jousting/Photo booth:

<u>Discussion:</u> Two of the finalized quotes for the bungee run and the jousting were provided to the committee. Both quotes were reasonable and were ready to be approved at the next meeting. However, it was decided by the committee to stray from using the bounce houses altogether as it provides a huge risk of liability, as well as a need for constant supervision throughout the entire event. It was decided to use the money for the bounce houses for a photo booth, and to incorporate 'lawn games' into the event instead. For example, to have 'beach ball golf', volleyball tournaments, and to play consoles on a projection screen.

**b.** Welcome Week events August 24th-28th

<u>Discussion</u>: This item was tabled for a later date in order for the committee to have an opportunity to further elaborate on ideas to contribute to the events of Welcome Week 2015.

- c. Taco Tuesdays
  - i. Guest Speakers
