7. RECEIPT OF CORRESPONDENCE TO THE SENATE

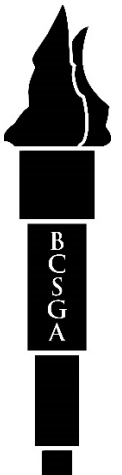
- a. Resignation of Silbano Lopez as Director of Public Relations
