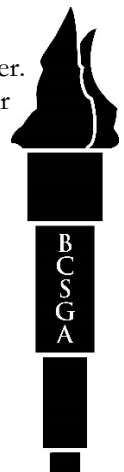
If budget allows, candy will be bought for Student Organizations. Entrance fee is \$1.00.
