MEMBERSHIP	The taskforce is co-chaired by 1 Administrative Co-Chair and 1 Faculty Co-Chair. All members have voting privileges unless otherwise indicated. Unfilled positions will not count towards quorum. Quorum will be one more than half the filled positions. • 7 faculty (1 from each area: EMLS, English, Math, Psychology, Technical Mathematics, Business, non-Math STEM) • 1 Curriculum Committee Co-Chair or designee representative • 2 Deans of Instruction (1 from STEM, 1 from English/EMLS) • 1 Office of Institutional Effectives Representative • 2 Counselors (1 from STEM, 1 other) • 1 SALT administrative representative • 1 Educational Advisor • 2 Student Representatives
