NAME OF TASKFORCE	BC AB 928 Implementation Task Force
COMMITTEE / TASKFORCE CHARGE	The AB 928 Implementation Task Force is a 2 -year ad hoc task force of the Academic Senate. The primary purpose of this taskforce is to explore and plan implementation processes for Bakersfield College related to AB 928, namely automatic enrollment of students who declare transfer as their goal into transfer degree paths and CalGETC alignment. The taskforce will: review guidance materials from the CCCCO and other related organizations. examine potential enrollment impacts. examine potential student journey impacts. examine potential curriculum workload impacts. develop an implementation plan and timeline.
SCOPE OF AUTHORITY	Make recommendations to Academic Senate and Vice President of Instruction. A report should be given to the Academic Senate every semester (Fall 23, Spring 24, Fall 24, Spring 25).
REPORTS OUT TO	Academic Senate and the Vice President of Instruction
COMMUNICATES WITH	Additionally, the taskforce will communicate regularly with areas through Curriculum Committee, Enrollment Management Committee, College Council, and FCDC.
MEMBERSHIP	The taskforce is co-chaired by 1 Administrative Co-Chair and 1 Faculty Co-Chair. All members have voting privileges unless otherwise indicated. Unfilled positions will not count towards quorum. Quorum will be one more than half the filled positions. • 3 faculty at large representatives from different Learning and Career Pathways • 1 Curriculum Committee Co-Chair or designee representative • 1 Articulation Officer or faculty designee • 1 Counselor • 1 Advisor • 1 Office of Institutional Effectiveness representative • 1 SALT administrative representative • 1 Dean of Instruction • 2 Student Representatives
