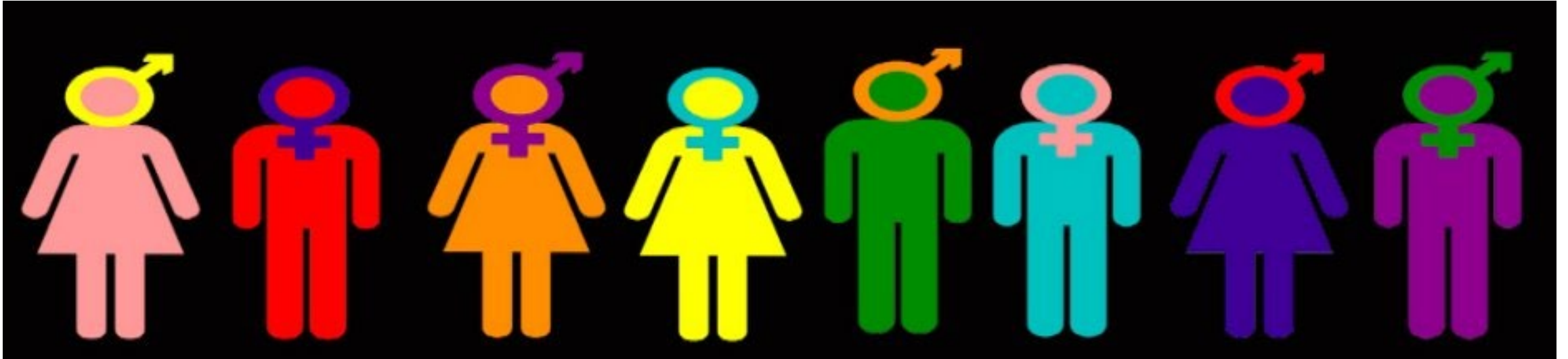

- Most have not had a previous sociology class

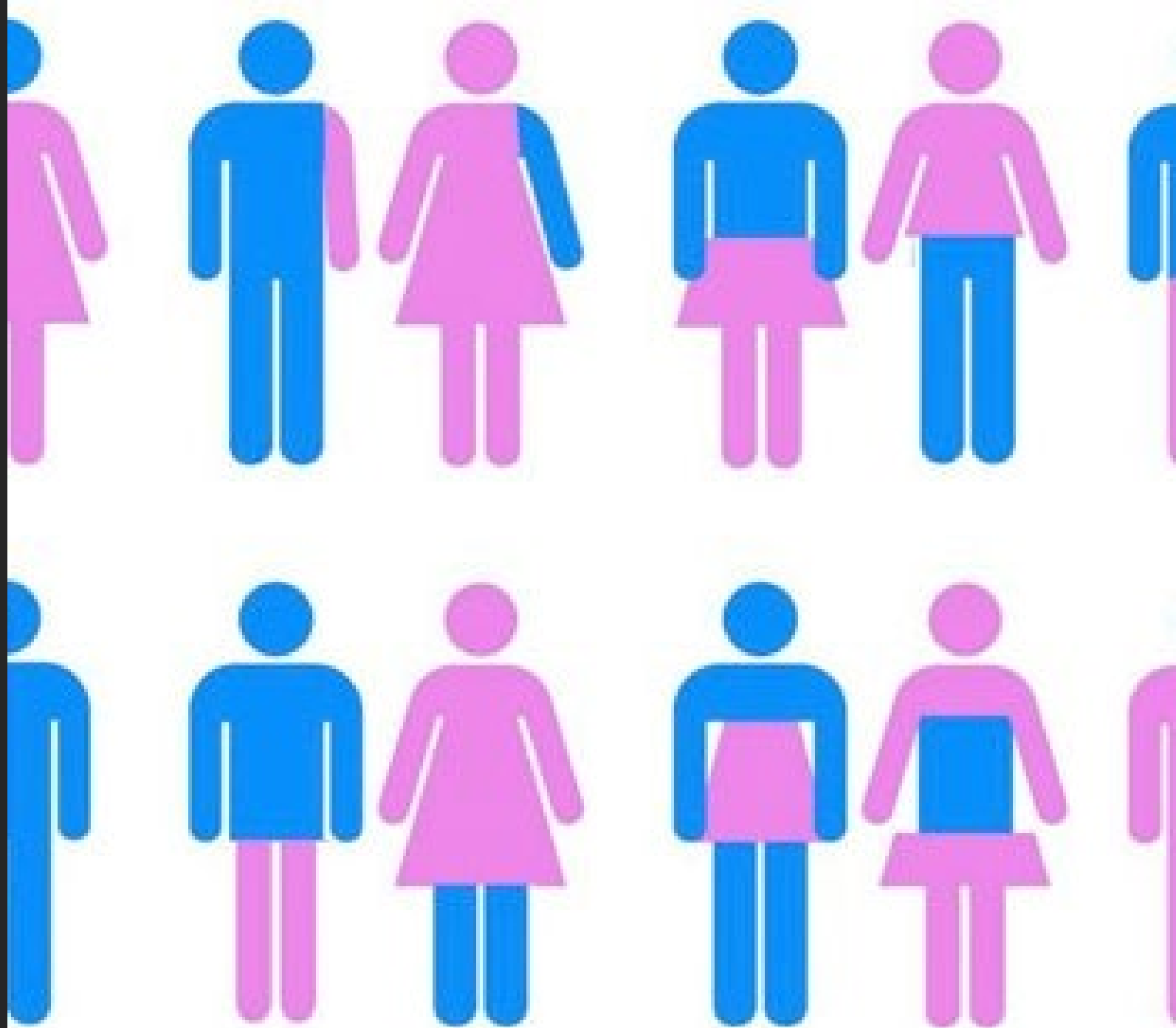

Reflect

Observations:

- ❑ Assignment is described as a “REFLECTION”
- ❑ Students overall identify a correct example of gender policing
- ❑ Student fail to identify the “rule” violated, the “account”, or analyze the success of the account



Refine

- Meets criteria for identifying agents of socialization
- Need assistance analyzing the elements of socialization behaviors
