NEW BUSINESS

AB 111 COR and Unit Requirements (Ellis/McGarrah)

Description: The new CalGETC (AB 928) will require 34 units of general education, but 7 units overlap for science and math. The total units are 36 + 34 - 7 = 63. No ADT can require more than 60 units. We do not have an option to cut any classes, and the unit counts align with C-ID, so we are looking for a way to offer this degree when CalGETC takes effect. This is a Discussion item.

Wade Ellis and James McGarrah provided a brief overview of the AB111 COR and Unit Requirements and asked for recommendations from the Senate.

Equivalency Committee Procedures Updates (Bligh)

Description: <u>Equivalency Procedures – draft of proposed updates</u>. This is a Discussion item. Kimberly Bligh presented the draft procedures as a first read.

Educational Master Plan (EMP)

Description: <u>The Educational Master Plan 2023-2028</u> is under review. This is a Discussion item.

Senate President Menchaca provided a brief overview of the changes to the EMP which has moved from a 3-year plan to a 5-year plan to align with our sister colleges and also to better clarify the rural initiatives.
