






Bridge to BC Cohorts: Fall 2014 through Fall 2023




Momentum Points: Attempting 15+ Units in First Term

First-Time Students Attempting 15+ Units in Their First Term




Momentum Points: Attempting 30+ Units in Year 1

First-Time Students Attempting 30+ Units in Their First Year




Momentum Points: Attempting 45+ Units in 1.5 Years

First-Time Students Attempting 60+ Units by the end of their Second Year




Momentum Points: Complete Transfer Level English in Year 1




Momentum Points: Complete Transfer Level Math in Year 1




Momentum Points: Complete Transfer Level English and Math in Year 1

First-Time Students Completing Transfer-Level English and Math by First Year:




Fall to Spring Persistence

Fall to Spring Persistence by: Summer Bridge Participants




