Work Experience

SECTION 55253:

- 14 hours instead of 16 maximum a semester

SECTION 55250:

- Paid and non-paid treated the same
- Can be noncredit
- Separation of Internship and Work Experience
- Required Documentation listed

MULTIPLE SECTIONS OF ARTICLE 4:

- Remove “Cooperative” from title

Supervised Tutoring

SECTION 53415:

- Removed reference to Learning Skills Coordinators and Tutoring Coordinators, leaving only Learning Assistance Instructor.
- Removed all reference to Tutoring as Criteria for Supervised Tutoring is defined in Section 58168.

SECTION 58160:

- Reorganized categories; changed phrasing (e.g. "courses and programs" to "Education programs")
- Added classes and support services, specifically added Tutoring as one of the NC categories and reiterated that support for transfer-level mathematics or English be provided. (AB1705)

SECTION 58168:

- Supervised tutoring must be ~~conducted~~ coordinated through a designated learning center and may be conducted either in person or virtually.
- Information moved from SECTION 58170 to here.
- Added requirements for tutor hiring and training.
- Specifically stated that tutors may be paid but cannot earn concurrent credit.

Local Degree Requirements

SECTION 55051:

- Added Ethnic Studies as a separate General Education requirement

SECTION 55062:

- Noncredit as an option if petitioned
- Credit for Prior learning as an option
- Only for choice in the 60 units towards GPA calculation
- General Education deemed completed for students with a Bachelor's degree
- Advise students on limitations for transfer
- Can accept institutionally accredited coursework

Upcoming – DEIA in the COR

SECTION 55001:

- Curriculum Committee definition and DEIAA training requirement

SECTION 55001.5:

- Curriculum Committee required to have procedure to ensure CORs demonstrate culturally responsive approach integrating DEIAA and guarantee of accessibility

SECTION 55002:

- Identify courses as degree-applicable or nondegree-applicable
- COR must include vocabulary, critical thinking and application of concepts at college level, reading and writing assignments
- CORs must be publicly available
