

SAMUEL W. MCCALL OUTSTANDING PROFESSOR OF THE YEAR AWARD

Every year, students nominate their professors to be the recipient of the Samuel W. McCall Outstanding Professor of the Year Award. The five top nominees subsequently become a finalist for this award. Twenty students with high academic excellence—each represent one of the academic departments on campus—study the finalists and select a winner based on the professor's contributions to his/her students and to the college community. The Student Affairs Office will contact department chairs requesting nominations of students from their area who have made the Dean's List and have a desire to participate on the selection committee.

Approximately one month prior to the Honor Brunch, information is submitted to the Renegade Rip requesting students to submit faculty names to the Student Affaris Office, CC4. The committee of students then confer and select a winner from the top five candidates. An advisor from the Student Affairs Office will serve as a non-voting member of the committee.

In May, the ASB President presents the oustanding faculty member with the perpetual plaque at the Honor Brunch. This year will mark the fourth such presentation. (Past recipients include Dr. George Lawrence, Clif Garrett, Jim Whitehouse and Shirley Trembley). The Associated Student Body, sponsors of the award program, is proud to spotlight the college's "super teachers". Each finalist is an outstanding teacher in his/her own right and also represent the many, many fine professors who can be found in departments across the campus.

CRITERIA FOR NOMINATION

Exhibits current and substantial knowledge of subject; is thoroughly prepared and organized; effectively communicates teaching techniques; is honest and fair with students; demonstrates a sense of caring for his/her students; displays extraordinary involvement with students; and demonstrates commitment to excellence above all at Bakersfield College.
