The last College Council Meeting was on Friday, April 8. Highlights from the College Council meeting:

- President Christian reported that BC is moving forward with plans for a Bond campaign (pending KCCD Board approval), and BC is moving forward with rolling out the Renegade Promise.
- Vice-President Gomez-Heitzeberg is chairing a committee to review the BC Administrative Structure. The committee is scheduled to report out its findings to College Council at the end of April.
- Dean Pluta led the College Council through a discussion of the College Council Strategic Directions report that is due to AIQ on April 21.
- Mark Staller presented the BC Accreditation timeline. Work on Accreditation will begin in earnest in Fall 2016, for an Institutional Self-Evaluation Report that is due Spring 2018. The ISER will include a Quality Focus Essay (QFE) containing two or three action projects.
- Mark Staller presented a preliminary draft of the written Strategic Enrollment Management Plan being prepared by the Enrollment Management Committee. The EMC will be presenting a completed draft of the SEMP to the campus community at the end of the Spring 2016 semester.
