ACCJC Midterm Report

- Approved by Senate (4/20/22)
- Approved by College Council (4/22/22)
- Approved by KCCD Board of Trustees (8/11/22)
- Next report will be the Institution Self Evaluation Report (ISER) due in 2025. BC's ISER will fall under the new standards expected to be in effect by 2025. ACCJC is hosting several free webinars for anyone interested in learning more <u>https://accjc.org/webinar/</u>.

Review of BC's Institution Set Standards (ISS)

- 2021-22 needs approved by Senate, 1st read was tabled end of spring, till fall, and then again at the first senate meeting. On agenda again September 21 for a first read.
- BC is meeting or exceeding standards. Some recommendations were proposed by AIQ for increasing standards we have well exceeded, using a 3 year average.
- Proposals for increases in aspirational goals are calculated on a 5% increase for 3 years.
