## Procedure for Standing Committee Slots With Multiple Nominees

- 1. All applicants for standing committee slots have a 48-hour window to apply for committee membership via the <u>Standing Committee Request Form</u> on the Senate's website.
- 2. If there are multiple applicants for a given standing committee slot who have applied within the 48-hour period that committee nominations begin [(start date & TIME) to (start date & TIME+48 hours)], a random lottery will be used to choose the person for the given standing committee slot.
- 3. The random lottery described in #2 above will be done at the first full Senate meeting of the academic year. Each applicant for a given slot will be assigned a number between 1 and the number of applicants. A random number generator such as the one at Random.org (or other engine) will be used to create a random number between 1 and the number of applicants. The applicant whose number matches the generated random number will be the nominated person for the slot.
