

EMERGENCY RESPONSE

- ⊙ Life Threatening, Personal Health or Injury
 - Someone falls seriously ill, loses consciousness, has an accident with serious injury that appears to be life threatening or requires immediate medical treatment.
 - Call 911
 - Notify Porterville College Nurse at ext. 2212
 - Call Switchboard (dial 0) to notify of situation

- ⊙ FIRE – At the Discovery of a FIRE:
 - If possible, use a FIRE EXTINGUISHER to control or put out the fire.
 - Dial 911 and call the Switchboard (dial 0) to notify of the situation.
 - Pull the FIRE ALARM and EVACUATE.
 - Assist disabled staff and/or students
 - Follow established evacuation routes

- ⊙ EARTHQUAKE
 - DROP / COVER / HOLD ON
 - After the earthquake look around to make sure nothing falls on you
 - Watch out for fallen power lines
 - Follow established evacuation routes

- ⊙ VIOLENCE ON CAMPUS
 - CALL 911 and then call Switchboard (dial 0).
 - Describe the violent act and give a detailed description of the assailant.
 - Attend to victim(s) until campus or emergency personnel arrive.
 - DO NOT PUT YOURSELF IN HARMS WAY.
 - CLEAR AND SECURE THE AREA. Do not touch any evidence around the victim. Instruct students and staff to leave the area where the violence occurred and to make sure no one except authorized personnel enter the area.

- ⊙ THREATENING SUICIDE
 - STAY CALM and call 911
 - DO NOT attempt to disarm and/or struggle with the person.
 - Attempt to CALM the person.
 - Remove bystanders and secure the area as best as possible.
 - Call the Switchboard (dial 0) and describe the nature of the emergency.
 - SUICIDE
 - Call 911, Check for signs of Life, secure the area.
