d. Market Sectors

Whatever PC puts out on the website needs to align with other colleges across California so we are all speaking the same language along with what our high schools are doing and the market sectors.

Dr. Simpkins shared the Metamajor at California Community Colleges spreadsheet which shows our major cluster names compared to what other colleges in our area are calling their pathways. Some colleges have more and some have fewer major groups, while the colleges do not always call the major groups the same names they often all use the same terminology. PC has used completely different terms which has come up in discussion several times. *See spreadsheet shared by Dr. Simpkins.*

A lot of high school pathways go straight to careers and is why Dr. Simpkins likes the Academic and Career Pathways as a term because it addresses both; those who will continue on in their education and those who will go straight into the workforce. Want to include the market sectors in our work (see list below) while focusing on our Pirate Map process, especially the ones within the region that the web recognizes as priority (in bold below) to not only align with the high school pathways but with the market sectors naming conventions of pathways so when students come to the onboarding process; the students take a career assessment, get into a pathway regarding the major cluster that aligns with the market sector and career, when the student completes, they understand the process.





Dr. Simpkins went over how he came to each version of the clusters. Want to address the issue with names of the clusters, what we will call the clusters, how many and the best way to organize the clusters. The committee discussed the different versions and the consensus is to have fewer cluster groups as fewer groups is more marketable. *Discussion ensued.*

Most discussion centered around versions 3 and 5. If PC adds anymore majors Araceli feels version 5 is more balanced but if PC is looking at growth she likes version 3 better. A recommendation for version 3 is to split education and add those majors to Arts, Humanities and social Science cluster. *Discussion ensued.*

The original clusters were created with not only faculty and staff but both student and community leaders. We need to consider getting feedback from our high schools and community leaders. VP Arvizu would like to get a consensus from this committee, then her and Dr. Simpkins can reach out to the High Schools Pathway Coordinator.

Dr. Simpkins will make the changes to version 3 and the updated version 3 and version 5 will be presented to Academic Senate, Enrollment Management and CC to see which version gets the most votes.

The committee also discussed changing Major Clusters to Academic and Career Pathways. After much discussion the committee took a vote on the name change and was approved by consensus of the committee.

h. Next Steps

- The committee will move forward aligning academics and market sectors with the remaining conventions of the major clusters.
- Recommendation is to send both version 3 and version 5 to Academic Senate (presented by Dr. Simpkins and Matthew Flummer), Enrollment Management (VP Primavera Arvizu) and CC. Final recommendation will come back to this committee.
- The inquiry teams will continue to work on their major cluster groups.
- Consolidating and standardizing the two-year plans. Goal is to have this completed by mid-summer.
