The Assessment Problem

- Our accrediting organization (ACCJC) requires that we assess our Individual Program Learning Outcomes and Student Learning Outcomes at least once every six years.
- The relatively new student success score card requires us to assess our Institutional Learning Outcome as well.

The Assessment Problem

- Assessing Learning Outcomes related to Sociology:
 - Institutional Learning Outcomes 4
 - Program Learning Outcomes 3
 - Student Learning Outcomes (Six courses) 19
 - Total assessments required 26

The Assessment Problem

- In order to complete the assessment for the discipline of sociology it will be necessary to conduct slightly more than two separate assessments each and every semester for the six year cycle.
- And sociology has a relatively small course load when compared to other disciplines at Bakersfield College.

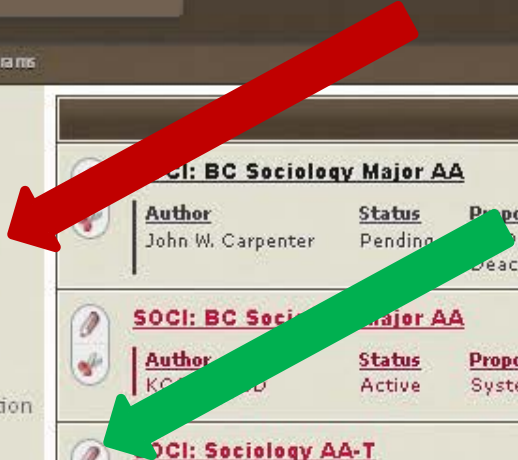

Making the Connection

Step by Step

- Establish a set of assessment questions for each Program Learning Outcome.
- Determine which of the individual Student Learning Outcomes and Institutional Level Outcomes are related in content and assess all related learning outcomes with a single process.

Step by Step

- Each assessment will involve a pre-test post-test format; however, the pre-test will be administered to a single, randomly selected class in an area.
- As an example: if there are ten offerings of SOCI B1 on the main campus at the beginning of a semester only one of those offerings would be randomly selected and given the pre-test during the first week of classes.

Step by Step

- At the end of the semester, all sections of a given course are administered a posttest, generally within the context of the final exam, and the random pre-test results would be utilized as a baseline for a comparison of means.
