

**Monthly Report ACH Pathway Completion Community April 2020**

All chairs have completed their Welcome Letters to be sent to majors. This includes Pathway information as well as the department chair, the Pathway counselor, and ed advisor's contact information.

We are asking chairs to determine how many students in their major have complete English and math to tailor messaging to those students to encourage them to take English and Math. Also, we are encouraging students to enroll in English and Math classes that have labs given the difference in success rates for students in English and Math labs.

We are working to revise Helen Acosta's slides to reflect the transition to an online environment, e.g. replacing physical locations with web address and adding Google numbers for counselors.

Kris Stallworth, the department chair for art, discussed the obstacles for art majors given that most art classes are studio classes. To help address that obstacle, we have asked Kris to consider offering more lecture and survey classes in fall in case we move online again, and save studio classes for Spring.

We are identifying students who still have the old AA degree declared on Starfish and make them aware of the AA-T major.

Finally, we are asking all chairs to look at what classes within department their majors are missing to identify bottlenecks and to get students graduating on time.
