## Highlights of 2013 Program Review Process

- 3-year comp review w/ Annual Update
- Streamlined forms
- Improved communication and transparency (website)
- Committee membership
- Improved training opportunities
- Extended P.R. timeline
- Initial feedback
  - 10 + 2 units
- Better integration of processes (institutional effectiveness & improvement; resource allocation; decision-making; curriculum management)

#### Common Themes & Issues

- 83% increase of program participation:
  - 2013: 57 instructional and 18 administrative or student service programs
  - 2012: 26 instructional and 15 administrative or student service programs
- Aging infrastructure
- Student demographics (increase in Hispanic student enrollment; decrease in African American student enrollment)
- Uncertainty of data use
- Data accuracy and relevance
- Technology disparity
- Classroom utilization & scheduling
- Increased personnel requests
- P.R. timeline still compressed
- More objective program self-assessment (multiple-measures and increased departmental collaboration)

## Opportunities for Future Growth

- Communication to participating units
- Inclusion of VP-level review
- Begin P.R. process earlier
