

Q1 How would you describe your overall level of understanding about the program review process at Bakersfield College?





Q2 Which employee category best describes your position at the college?





Q3 As an editor, approver, or participant on a team, was the trend data provided you by Institutional Research meaningful and relevant to the annual program review process?








Q6 How much dialogue during the program review process occur within your program/area during the development of your AU or Comprehensive this past year?










Q9 What type of training works best for your area?


Q10 In reference to the new Budget Form, do you understand the correlation between the old and the new process? What can we do to communicate this more effectively?
