A BILL

MANDATING ATTENDANCE OF I.C.C. BOARD REPRESENTATIVES

- 1 *Whereas, it shall be the responsibility of the Department on Student Organizations to execute*
2 *its laws, affairs, and functions*
- 3 *Whereas, the Interclub Council (ICC) meetings are not being held with a mandatory*
4 *attendance from the Department on Student Organizations*
- 5 *Whereas, many ICC representatives from registered StudOrgs have not attended meetings*
6 *often, or at all, as tracked by attendance records*
- 7 *Whereas, the ICC representatives who are failing to attend the meetings are also not*
8 *obtaining the information presented, either from other representatives or the Department on*
9 *Student Organizations*
- 10 *Whereas, according to COBRA 502.10(b):*
- 11 *Each registered StudOrg should send their ICC Representative (ICC Rep) to the*
12 *meetings*

1 1) If the ICC Rep is not able to attend, it is the responsibility of the StudOrg Leadership
2 to send an alternative member to the ICC Meeting or connect with the Director to receive
3 missed information so that attendance of said ICC Rep is met.

4 Whereas, many ICC representatives have yet to comply with this request

5 Whereas, mandatory attendance of all ICC representatives/alternates is crucial in order to
6 help the StudOrg be well informed

7 Whereas, mandatory attendance will allow the ICC to be a more effective, involved, and
8 cohesive body within BCSGA

9 Whereas, the mandatory attendance will allow for the ICC representatives who are actively
10 engaging with the Department on Student Organizations and BCSGA to have a stronger,
11 unified organizational voice

12 Whereas, this stronger, unified organizational voice will allow the ICC to have more power of
13 influence within the Department on Student Organizations

14 Whereas, the ICC representatives who fail to attend should relinquish all rights to the ICC
15 rep, should be held accountable by

16 Whereas, ICC representatives that are unable to attend should notify the StudOrg board to
17 then later receive information on current agendas, future events, etc.

18 Whereas, All ICC representatives who fail to notify the StudOrg of their absence before a
19 meeting, will have it marked against them as an unexcused absence for that ICC meeting.

20 Whereas, if the ICC representative in question has accumulated a certain amount of
21 absences, their rights to the ICC will be relinquished, including funding.

22 Whereas, all ICC members will hereby be put in to a tier system category of attendance in
23 such order:

24 Tier 1- Perfect attendance and participation in all ICC meetings and endeavors.

25 Tier 2: Moderate attendance and acceptable participation in ICC meetings and endeavors.

26 Tier 3: Poor attendance and no participation in ICC meetings or endeavors. (Missing 3 or
27 more meetings.)

1 *Whereas, the ICC representatives who are actively attending (tier 1 & tier 2) should be*
2 *compensated in the following ways.*

3 *#1: All unused funds will be divided up equally to then be granted/disbursed to all ICC*
4 *members for their clubs who have shown great attendance and commitment to the job as an*
5 *ICC representative.*

6 *However, all funds allocated to any ICC member for events, supplies, etc. will have to be*
7 *witnessed and monitored by the clubs Advisor, and will have to report back to the ICC board*
8 *with an immediate report on how the funds were spent for future records.*

9 *#2: For all ICC representatives who have good attendance, a student at large vote will be*
10 *appointed in your favor during ICC meetings to give you as a majority the right to a vote on*
11 *the ICC board.*

12 *#3 ICC members with regular attendance will be granted priority for room registration through*
13 *a tier system: SGA, ICC members with good attendance, and ICC members with moderate*
14 *attendance.*

16 *Be it enacted by the Senate of the Bakersfield College Student Government Association,*
17 *That a tier system for all ICC representatives will but put into place for the mandate of*
18 *attendance for all current and future ICC board members to all future ICC board meetings;*
