**A BILL**

Creation of the Codes of the Bakersfield Renegade Association (COBRA)

1       *Whereas, one the Bakersfield College's goal is "Student Success: Become an exemplary model of student success*  
2 *by developing and implementing best practices".*

3       *Whereas, BCSGA is developing a more efficient and effective government to represent the student population at*  
4 *Bakersfield College;*

5       *Whereas, the various BCSGA codes have been created in the past and have been lost, no longer used, forgotten,*  
6 *or in conflict with each other;*

7       *Whereas, in order for the government to be more direct and strategically plan for future growth;*

8       *Whereas, BCSGA Officers need a single source where all BCSGA codes are housed and referenced;*

9       *Whereas, all pertaining bylaws of the association must only be listed within a single reference manual;*

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate of the Bakersfield College Student Government Association, establishes the Codes of*  
2 *the Bakersfield Renegade Association (otherwise known as the COBRA) to carry out its function and mission;*

3        *Be it further enacted by the Bakersfield College Senate of the Student Government Association, the purpose of*  
4 *this manual is to provide a single, well-organized document that encompasses all the established bylaws, protocols,*  
5 *agreements, etc. of the Bakersfield College Student Government Associated at Bakersfield College;*

6        *Be it further enacted by the Senate, the BCSGA Advisor shall be entrusted with the maintenance,*  
7 *implementation, and execution of the COBRA and its contents;*

8        *Be it further enacted by the Senate, the COBRA must be reviewed annually by the Senate Standing Committee*  
9 *on Governmental Operations;*

10       *Be it further enacted by the Senate, any future bylaws, codes, protocols, agreements, or other related items must be*  
11 *incorporated into the COBRA;*

12       *Be it further enacted by the Senate, at the passing of the COBRA all previously known bylaws, codes, protocols,*  
13 *agreements, and other related items be null and shall be resubmitted to the Senate to added into the COBRA for*  
14 *recognition and implementation.*
