### **A RESOLUTION**

For the Painting of Marked Parking Spaces on All Free Street Parking Around the Panorama Campus

1 Whereas, the Bakersfield College Student Government Association is established to 2 "promote the general welfare, the morale of the students, and advocate [on] behalf of the student 3 voice" (COBRA 201.01(a)); 4 Whereas, the Senators are charged with "generating bills and resolutions which best reflect 5 the needs and voices of the students during the term as Senator" (COBRA 301.03(a)); 6 Whereas, current enrollment of students at Bakersfield College has grown to exceed 25,000 7 students: 8 Whereas, the issue of free parking off-campus has historically been a concern among the 9 entire student body, causing numerous complaints, disputes, and city municipal legislation to 10 create and enforce residential parking permits and regulations;

1	Whereas, the students of Bakersfield College have been consulted in various ways to gather	
2	information and ideas for improving and enforcing parking regulations both on- and off-campus,	
3	with little to no effect;	
4	Whereas, vehicles continue to be improperly parked in the street parking areas around the	
5	Panorama campus, which issue may be alleviated by improving the campus perimeter parking	
6	with the addition of space markings (called "parking 'T's) indicating appropriate parallel parking	
7	spaces;	
8	Be it resolved by the Senate of the Bakersfield College Student Government Association,	
9	a)	That the street parking around the perimeter of the Panorama campus be marked,
10		in all areas designated as "free parking," with clearly marked spaces/stalls, including
11		but not limited to Mount Vernon Avenue, University Avenue, Haley Street,
12		Panorama Drive;
13	b)	That these areas of free parking continue to hold no time restriction on how long a
14		student may park his/her vehicle for campus purposes
15	Be it further resolved by the Senate,	
16	a)	That enforcement of proper vehicle parking be performed in accordance with all City
17		of Bakersfield municipal and vehicle codes and regulations by the Bakersfield Police
18		Department;
19	Be it further resolved by the Senate,	
20	a)	That this resolution be sent to the Office of Public Safety for Bakersfield College to
21		be submitted to the City of Bakersfield Public Works Division as the petition by the
22		student of Bakersfield College for this work to be performed
