5. Assembly Bill 927

[AB-927 Public postsecondary education: community colleges: statewide baccalaureate degree program](#)

- Signed by Governor Newsome on October 6, 2021
- This bill would extend the operation of the statewide baccalaureate degree pilot program indefinitely allowing for a total of 30 baccalaureate degree programs per academic year.
- Cannot offer a baccalaureate or program curriculum at CSU or UC
- A community college district is provided with two timelines in which to apply for a baccalaureate degree program per year. A community college district may submit an application to the Chancellor of the California Community Colleges by no later than January 15 and shall receive notice of approval or rejection on or before May 31. A community college district may submit an application to the Chancellor of the California Community Colleges by no later than August 15 and shall receive notice of approval or rejection on or before December 31.
 - o Thinking first opportunity will be August 15, 2022 or maybe Jan 15, 2023.
