Low Enrollment Sections - Sections with fewer than 20 students (cross-listed sections were combined)

Does not include sections requiring special approval to enroll, Work Experience, or full sections with maximum seats of less than 20.

BC = 288 (including 1 cross-listed group)

CC = 165 (including 14 cross-listed groups)

PC = 96 (including 6 cross-listed groups)

On-line (current enrollment activity; sections were adjusted to count each cross-listed group as one section)

BC = 77 sections; 3,349 enrollments; 347.2 Current FTES; 2,284 unduplicated students; 20.7 FTES/FTEF

CC = 173 sections; 4,796 enrollments; 445.5 Current FTES; 2,465 unduplicated students; 11.8 FTES/FTEF

PC = 26 sections; 678 enrollments; 64.1 Current FTES; 511 unduplicated students; 11.5 FTES/FTEF

On-line sections as a percent of all Fall 2013 sections:

BC = 5%; **CC** = 37.4%; **PC** = 7%

On-line enrollments as a percent of all Spring 2014 enrollments:

BC = 8%; **CC** = 60%; **PC** = 9%

Delano = 127 sections; 2,522 enrollments; 312.8 Current FTES; 1,215 unduplicated students; 11.2 FTES/FTEF

Weill = 16 sections; 313 enrollments; 53.6 Current FTES; 270 unduplicated students; 12.1 FTES/FTEF

Bishop/Mammoth = 43 sections; 577 enrollments; 81.4 Current FTES; 239 unduplicated students; 6.4 FTES/FTEF

KRV/South Kern = 42 sections; 456 enrollments; 52.6 Current FTES; 195 unduplicated students; 6.1 FTES/FTEF
