There were 34 members voting. Two-thirds of 34 is 23 (round up to a whole person). The By-Laws change required two more votes than received.

* CORRECTED NOTE: Article XI, Section 2 of the By-Laws states: "Amendments to these By-Laws shall be ratified by two-thirds vote of the Senate (body rep.) members, present and voting". There were 32 members voting ("abstain" is the same as not voting), therefore, 22 votes were needed to change the By-Laws.
