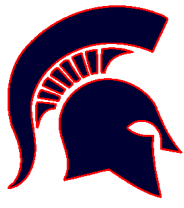

Chariman's Report- Allen Ishida

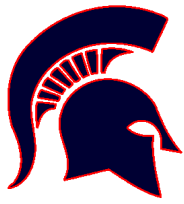
- Jake Duffin was nominated as Vice Chair, Robert LoBue motioned and Randy Wallace 2nd the motion, it was agreed upon unanimously.
