

SLO Synchronization

Faculty Origination

This handout will show the process for synching SLOs between Canvas and eLumen when Faculty originate the process.

1. Step one, faculty create an assessment. If you are unfamiliar with this process, see the handout entitled *Creating an Individual Assessment*.
2. Faculty send outcomes to LMS.

In this step you will click the checkbox next to the assessment information you would like to send to Canvas. Once you have clicked that box, you will see a screen that looks like this. Click Send Outcomes to LMS.



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Once you click that button you will see a screen that looks like this. You will need to choose the course you want to send the outcomes to and then click Send Outcomes.



After you hit send outcomes, you will see a notice that says Exporting Outcomes and then it will switch to Successfully Exported.

3. Create an assignment in Canvas using your outcomes.

Now we move over to Canvas. You will create an assignment in Canvas as you normally do. You might title it whatever your assessment is titled in eLumen. Be sure to give it points. Also, make sure you create a method of submission. Save your assignment when you have entered the initial data.

4. Add the rubric and find your outcomes.

In the assignment you just saved, you will see a screen like this. Click +Rubric.


